




NO.1 TILES FOR THE FLOOR


Floor tiles add a fresh feeling to a room and transform it in a spacious way. It may create a harmonic composition with the wall tiles, or a signature part of an interior design.

Gorbon allows you to choose among non-slip grainy floors, resistant to intense water tiles, or just characteristic designs for indoors.










NO.2 GORBON QUARTZ TILES

Gorbon Quartz Tile is known for its durability and its deep colors, thanks to its material mixture. The mixture contains approximately 70 percent of quartz and quartzite. Distinct glaze applications are made courtesy of its complicated organic composition, which results in wonderful tiles.












NO.3 GORBON TRADITIONAL TILES

Gorbon Traditional Tile is a technique developed within Gorbon, about 50 years ago. Applied on red soil raw material, it is made by hand painting, with a very little relief. Its most important feature is that it is very durable. Compared to Gorbon Quartz Tiles, it has an easier production method. The tiles on the Mecca Gate structure, located at the entrance of the city of Mecca, were produced by Gorbon with this technique.










NO.4 TILES WITH RELIEF

Gorbon has a very big skill in producing 3D tiles. Based on the project requirements from the client, we would create a custom mould and a prototype in a very short time. Gorbon 3D printing atelier is mostly working for this area. At the same time, we would make new glazes for the surface. Once the client approves the samples, production starts. Gorbon 3D tiles are made of earthenware or stoneware. All glazes are made in house. Industry standards are followed and the products are very durable. Custom tile sizes vary from 5cm to 50 cm.












NO.5 CERAMIC & PORCELAIN POOL TILES

Aside from durable porcelain pool tiles, for more distinguished uses, water resistant ceramic tiles are also an option.









NO.6 TERRACOTTA TILES

Gorbon Terracotta Tiles go through an artisanal production process, where the aim is to achieve exceptional rubric looks such as burnt, fluidic colored, bumpy and more. Each Terracotta Tile is handcrafted and suitable for both outdoor and indoor coverings, offering you to create an Antique setting, with a Mediterranean breeze.









NO.7 FLAT TILES FOR THE WALL










NO.8 HANDMADE MOSAIC TILES










NO.9 LAVA STONE TABLE TOPS

Lava Stone is a very durable and long-lasting natural stone obtained from extinct volcanoes. It goes through a similar glazing process as ceramics do, but glazed Lava Stones have a plus side when it comes to choosing outdoor furnishing materials. After the firing process, glaze and stone make harmonized, resistant surfaces. At Gorbon we create plain but artful color works on lava stones, and also nature-centered patterns which will go perfectly at a back yard or a patio, and more.


